Taking care of our residents

Carlton Senior Living is committed to keeping our residents safe while providing an environment that will allow them to flourish. In this effort, all new residents will be tested prior to moving into Carlton or returning from a hospital setting. Residents will continue to be screened for symptoms on a daily basis. If a resident tests positive, whether asymptomatic or symptomatic, they will isolate in a separate bedroom until the following conditions are met:

- *At least 3 days (72 hours) have passed since recovery, defined as resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications; and**
- *Respiratory symptoms resolved (e.g., cough & shortness of breath); and**
- *At least 14 days have passed since symptoms first appeared.**

Socialization is one of the most important aspects of Assisted Living. We have opened our common spaces to allow our residents to participate in small, limited (10 or less) group activities where they can keep 6 feet apart. We are cleaning and disinfecting all common spaces after each use. Engaging with other seniors is beneficial in many ways, and we are **thankful to**

each of you for helping create these opportunities for our residents!
